

Summer Reading 2020 Instructions

Due to continued concern about gatherings, we have decided to cancel our summer reading programs this year. However, we will still be continuing with our reading logs and book incentives. Your child can still receive prizes for reading books this summer!

Summer Reading

-If your child is 4 or older, download and print the Book Log 2020 from our website. Write your child's name, age, and grade they just finished at the top of this book log. Keep track of the books they are reading in this log. This includes ones they are reading themselves, ones you read together, and ones you read to them. Download a book log for **each** child participating.

-We will have two prize stores this summer, one on June 26th and one on July 31st. These will be curbside stores, as the building will still be closed. Follow along on our website and Facebook page for an announcement on how this will work. We are thinking some kind of prize catalog you can print and view beforehand.

-How to calculate "Book Bucks" earned:

Children age 6 years old and under get a book buck for every 2 books read. Board books can't count for Summer Reading. Please keep track of the book titles on your book log—given to you on your first day.

If you just finished :

2nd grade: 25 pages—2 book bucks

3rd grade: 50 pages—2 book bucks

4th grade: 75 pages—2 book bucks

5th & 6th grade: 100 pages = 2 bb

7th & 8th grade: 150 pages = 2bb

9th and above: 100 pages = 1bb

bb = book buck

-You can either calculate these before coming to the prize store or ask your librarian to do so the day of. If you are calculating yourself, your librarian always rounds up to the nearest “book buck.”

Rubber Ducky Club

-If your child is aged 3 or under, they may participate in Rubber Ducky Club

-On our website, we will have a monthly “Rubber Ducky Activity Sheet.” Download, print, and complete the various activities on the sheet. When you finish an activity, color in the duck. When they complete 6 activities, your child receives a free duck. When they complete all twelve, they receive a free board book.

-To receive the ducks and books, please call ahead to let us know you are on your way. Then pull up outside in your vehicle, and your librarian will deliver a duck and/or book to you. For your safety, we will choose the duck and book so we don’t have too many people handling the materials.

-We will have a new activity every month.
